- ▶ Phil's session described working with the Board to ensure the PI program met Part IV for MOC (led to higher completion rates)

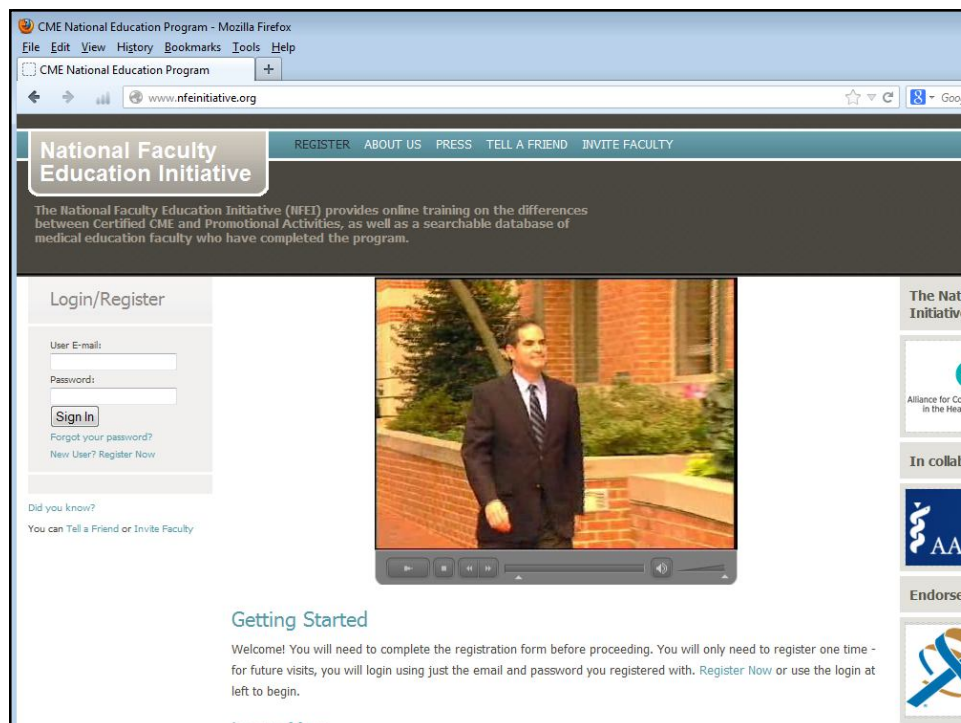

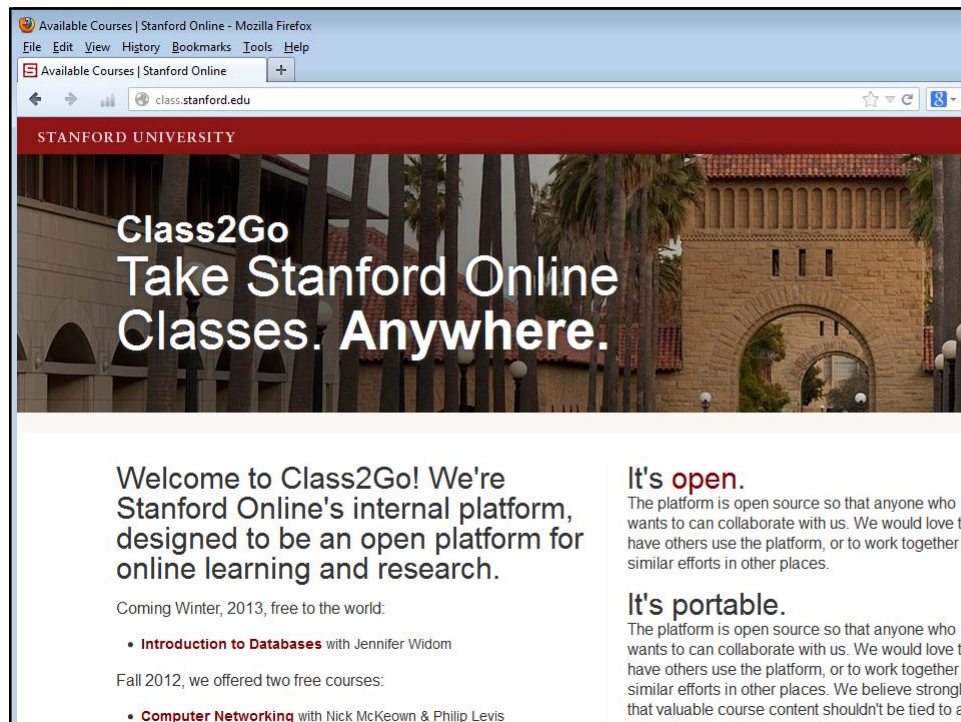
